October 14, 2014

Old Business: September 28, 2014 was our Club's All Ford Show. A big Thank-you to all who helped in any way!!!! Many compliments were received from participants regarding the show. We had a total of 171 cars. At the show we presented Colonel Folsom with a check for \$1000 to go towards the Wounded Warrior Program. We have since then received a Thank-you letter from Colonel Folsom thanking the club for our support. So again, Thank-you to all for your continued support of this very deserving program. We will be booking the same location for our show again next year. The date is Sunday September 27, 2015. Metro community college in Elkhorn will be the back-up location. New Business: Election of Officers- All officers same for 2015.

Dennis T. gave an update regarding the Midwest Ford Club which consists of our club, the Lincoln Mustang, Columbus Mustang and the Omaha Model A Car Clubs. Dennis T. is currently the treasurer. John B is also on the board. Each club received \$1,500 which will be donated to each club's chosen charity(s). We again will be donating to the Paul Brown memorial and the Wounded Warrior Program. Dennis stated we are currently looking for a volunteer from our Club to be a representative. Dean C. gave an update on MCA activities. He attended the Judges meeting in Savannah GA. More information was given on the Motto software. It will go live next year in 2015. MCA is planning on turning it over to each club so they can use it for their own club shows. Motto will help in a lot of ways. Normally each year we have to ask members for their MCA membership numbers. With Motto this will no longer be needed. MCA officers have changed. Steve Mays will be the President. Mary Jean has retired so taking her place as Editor will be Donald Farr. He has also written the book 50 years of the Mustang. Regarding the MCA show classes, every year a new class for 10 year cars is available. Example- 2005 will now be in a concors class. MCA is doing away with the Grand National term. They will now have 4 shows per year. Main reason for this change is the cost to put on a show. Also changing is the judging of the concors cars. Because it takes 1-1 1/2 hours per car to judge it is extremely difficult to do the judging just on the one day of Saturday. So now, new will be the judging of these cars on Friday and Saturday. MCA is striving to get judging done sooner so entrants can see the sites in the sponsor's town. Also, the MCA decals will no longer earn 1 point towards your total score. Also discussed was that in the daily driven and occasionally driven cars, it seemed that all were having trophy's awarded. To help remedy this, MCA will send out gold card judges to do a seminar a month ahead of the shows. Next years shows will be located at Tucson, AZ in March 2015, May 22 Grovetown, GA, July 17 Loveland, Co, and Sept 3 Columbus, OH. If anyone has joined MCA and has not received their MCA decal, send an email to President Amber B and she will forward to Dean. MCA membership dues are \$50 per year.
